The Young Leaders Program aims to help the next generation of leaders achieve their potential. It is managed by the International Leaders Program team at the University's Office of Global Engagement.

The Environment and Sustainable Development Program is a customised non-award academic course with a focus on some of the most critical issues in environment and sustainable development in Australia and the world.

The program is delivered as a combination of lectures, seminars, group work and educational trips. It draws on the knowledge of experts from the University, industry and government agencies to provide students with a wide ranging perspective.

In addition, students will learn about Australian culture, enhance their intercultural awareness and develop leadership skills. Students will also be able to interact with academics, industry experts and the community throughout the program.

Participants

University students from any academic area, at any level of study with a strong interest in environment and sustainability are welcome to apply.

The program will be taught entirely in English, therefore an adequate English language ability including listening and speaking is essential.

Participants will have the opportunity to study alongside students from other leading Chinese universities.

Program fee

The program fee of \$3,680 in Australia dollars per student covers:

- airport group pick-up on 20 January and transfer on 02 February Students who are not able to meet the group pick up and transfer time will need to make their own travel arrangements to the accommodation. Travel instructions will be provided.

- Certificate of Attendance and Program
